The only small hiccup is that this year's budget was based on 280 enrollment and our count period funding, we have 258 students, equating to being overfunded \$220,000. We were expecting to roll over 252,000. All of the other accounts look healthy. Shana is doing a great job! She's created the preliminary/projected budget for next year.</p> <p>3.
